The F.A.S. - Fine At School project, supported by Erasmus Plus Programme EACEA/34/2015 – “European policy experimentations in the fields of Education, Training and Youth led by high-level public authorities”, intends to be a modern and useful intervention to face the Early School Leaving (ESL) phenomenon.

Its main aims are: the prevention of ESL, the promotion of diversity, tolerance and inclusion in the learning environments, to ensure the educational success of children in primary and secondary junior schools, especially in areas at risk, or those who have disadvantaged backgrounds, encourage the choice of an appropriate study course.

Under the supervision of the competent public authorities, there were planned and developed specific experimental activities at policy level to prevent and reduce ESL rate by the realisation of on-field research, training and evaluation activities, workshops, promotion and dissemination of results and outcomes.

The finest way to achieve the project’s aims is the use of an inclusive education, composed of different approaches based on emotional dimensions of scholastic experience, creating basis and favouring the growth of pupils awareness about their skills, inclinations, fundamental values and social competences, addressing diversity in learning environment.

The project lasts 4 years and it provides the collaboration of organisations from different EU countries, establishing a Partnership, in order to apply and decline the activities in several dissimilar contexts, collect as many data as possible and interfere on a large scale, guaranteeing more benefits.
